



CABINS RULES & REGULATIONS

The following list DOES NOT constitute a COMPLETE set of the Rules and Regulations governing the Santee Lakes Recreation Preserve. You may request a complete set of the Rules and Regulations at the Park Office during business hours. It is your responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations at this facility.

OCCUPANCY & EXPECTATIONS OF GUESTS DURING THEIR STAY

The Cabins are not designed for large gatherings and therefore the maximum capacity at a Cabin site (interior and exterior) must not exceed six individuals. Violation of this policy shall result in the eviction of the entire party from the Cabin and Park without refund. Occupancy and use of each Cabin shall not disturb or offend neighbors or nearby residents. Padre Dam MWD has the right to terminate any rental agreement and to ask disruptive guests to leave the Park. Guests are expected to use the Cabin and equipment with care and caution. We expect no damage to the Cabin and equipment to occur during the reservation. We expect guests to inform us when accidents do occur so we can work towards an appropriate solution. There is no smoking or vaping allowed in the Cabins.

ONE VEHICLE PER CABIN IS ALLOWED: Please park all other cars in visitor parking. All extra vehicles must be registered at the Park Office, or pay the day use fee at the front gate. Parking pass must be displayed. No sleeping in vehicles.

VISITORS ARE WELCOME FROM 8:00 AM - 10:00 PM:

Registered guests are held responsible for the actions and behavior of their visitors while in the Park.

QUIET TIME SHALL BE OBSERVED FROM 9:00 PM - 8:00 AM:

During quiet time, loud talking, music, and other disturbing activities are not permitted. Minors under the age of eighteen not accompanied by an adult are required to be in their cabin by 9:00 PM.

PETS:

Pets are not allowed in or around the Cabins.

GROUND FIRES:

Ground fires are not allowed anywhere in the Park except in designated fire rings. Wood is available for purchase at the General Store. All fires must be extinguished by 10:00 PM.

CHECK OUT TIME IS 10:30 AM:

Cabin guests may extend their stay for additional nights depending on availability. If you wish to extend your stay, please contact the Park Office before 10:00 AM. All belongings must be removed and Cabins keys returned by 10:30 AM.

EXPECTATIONS OF GUESTS UPON CHECK-OUT:

During a reservation, daily housekeeping will not be provided. It is the guest's responsibility to keep the Cabin clean and undamaged. **Upon check-out, guests are required to do the following:** Clean and dry any dishes and utensils you used and return them to the appropriate drawers or cabinets, pick up your garbage in and around the Cabin and place it in the provided garbage cans, make sure all Cabin equipment/furnishings are returned to their proper location, sweep floors, and remove all food.

AFTER HOURS PARK ACCESS:

The main gates are locked at Park closing. Registered guests may use the auxiliary gate located on Fanita Parkway. Gate codes are changed every Monday and can be obtained from the Park Office, front Gatehouse or Camp Host.

PARK OFFICE/STORE HOURS:

The Park Office hours are 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM everyday. The General Store is open until 6:30 PM on Friday-Sunday evenings from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

CLEANLINESS:

Cabin site cleanliness is required for aesthetic, sanitary, and safety purposes. Guests must place trash in one of the trash receptacles located throughout the area. The nearest trash dumpster is located east of the Cabins along the main Park road. No clotheslines strung between Cabins, trees, etc. Items that are prohibited outside the Cabin include but are not limited to: furniture, toys, storage containers, off-road vehicles, plants, refrigerators/ freezers, debris, televisions, tarps/canopies, trash, tools, excessive fire wood, etc. Items that are permitted include: bikes, lawn chairs, and recreation related equipment. It is at

the discretion of the Park Staff to determine whether the Cabin site is in compliance.

SWIMMING POOL:

Use of the swimming pools and spa (**18 years and over**) is limited to campers and their registered guests. Swimming pools (one heated) are open year-round from 10:00 AM to 9:00 PM. For the convenience of those with small children, swim pants are available at the General Store. ***Diapers are not allowed in the pool.*** No lifeguard on duty. Adult supervision is required for minors.

LAUNDRY FACILITIES:

Laundry facilities are located in the Clubhouse building across from the Willow Loop. The laundry facility is open from 8:00 AM - 9:00 PM. Last wash is at 7:30 PM and last dry is 8:15 PM. Change is available at the Park Office on a limited basis. The operating fees for the washing machines and dryers are posted in the laundry room.

FISHING:

Fishing is permitted in the day use area during the posted Park hours with a Day Use Fishing Permit. Registered guests may fish Lakes 6 & 7 from sunrise to sunset with a Day Use Fishing Permit and from 5:00 PM to 11:00 PM with a Night Fishing Permit. Night fishing is limited to registered campers only and is only permitted in Lakes 6 & 7. Lakes 6 & 7 are for current registered guests only. A Santee Lakes Fishing Permit is required to fish any and all lakes. Fishing Permits may be purchased at the General Store. A California State Fishing License is not required. Santee Lakes Recreation Preserve is stocked on a regular basis (check with General Store staff for more details). Please check with General Store Staff to see which lakes are open for fishing. A fish cleaning station is located at Lake 5 across from the General Store. ***Please do not clean fish in the Cabins or on Cabin decks.***

VEHICLE SPEED LIMIT:

Guests shall not operate any vehicle within Santee Lakes Recreation Preserve at a speed in excess of the posted speed limit. No guest shall drive a vehicle within Santee Lakes Recreation Preserve other than in a reasonable and prudent manner with due regard for traffic and road conditions. In no event shall a vehicle be driven at a speed, which endangers the safety of persons, property, or wildlife.

ELECTRIC VEHICLE/GOLF CART USE:

Guests using electric vehicles and/or golf carts within the Park boundaries shall strictly obey all State and local vehicle operation statutes, codes, and regulations; shall only operate on designated roadways; shall obey all of the rules listed above. The operators of an electric cart and/or golf cart within the Park boundaries must possess a valid driver's license. Golf carts must be registered at the Park Office.

DAY USE AREA:

Guests are encouraged to utilize the Day Use facilities located on Lakes 1 - 5. The Day Use area includes: playgrounds, barbeques, horseshoe lanes, volleyball courts, pedal boats, rowboats and canoes. Equipment for horseshoes and volleyball is available for rent at the Park Office.. There is no smoking or vaping allowed in the Day Use Area.

WILDLIFE:

Please maintain a safe distance between you and all species of wildlife. Rattlesnakes and coyotes are common to our area. Please keep an eye on your children. Properly store all food and trash to avoid ant problems. Please consult a Park Staff member before using any form of pesticide. Report any dangerous situations to Park Staff.

HORSESHOE PIT & BASKETBALL HOOP

Horseshoe lane and basketball hoop are located on the west side of the Cabins area. Horseshoes and basketballs are available from your Cabins Host.
